Together you'll discover how you will listen to God and get into motion. A Discipler gives you support, encouragement and prayer for the journey. They'll hold you accountable along the way.

How do I find a Discipler?

Talk with your Small Group Leader about why you want to grow in faith. They may have a suggestion of a Discipler in your group, or you may have already been forming the foundations for such a relationship with someone in your group. Your group leader can help you form some ground rules and guides for your conversations using the Spiritual Life Assessment to chart your map.
